

ADVOCATES DIVISION 2005/06

In 2005/06 the LARC Advocates Division oversaw the final implementation of the county-wide Rockland Images project. This three-stage effort first inventoried photographs and postcards in local public libraries in 2004 and published a finder's guide to that inventory in the same year. LARC distributed the guide throughout the lower Hudson Valley at libraries and government offices, etc.

Late in 2005 we began digitizing the images in the libraries and mounting them on Southeastern New York Library Resource Council's Hudson River Valley heritage website (www.hrvh.org). The holdings of New City Library and Pearl River Library are now on the internet with holdings of the Palisades Free Library to be mounted soon. Eventually all the holdings of participating Rockland libraries will be available on the worldwide web.
